As you enter the building please follow the signs to the commons area. You will begin by picking up your class schedule. The last station of the enrollment process will be the pay station. We ask for everyone to plan on paying enrollment fees at this time. An exception will be made for anyone with a completed waiver letter. Please see the fee schedule for further information.

A separate payment/check will need to be written for cafeteria fees and BCCC enrollment fees.

All students will have a photo taken for their student ID.

No hats will be allowed.

The first day of school this year will be August 23rd and will be freshmen only. Students will be involved in learning the building, planning for a successful high school career, navigating the lunchroom, and exploring activity options during the day. Attendance is required. Only freshmen are allowed in the building this day.

August 24th will be the first full day for all students and the **RED** day schedule will be followed.
