

Barton County Sheriff's Reserves Scholarship

The Sheriff's Reserves Program has been a positive force to our young people in our community for many years. In continuing to do so and to promote new employees, the Barton County Sheriff's Reserves have established a scholarship for two graduating seniors from any high school in Barton County. The scholarship, which is renewable for the second year of school, will be used towards education in Law Enforcement.

Students interested in applying for this scholarship must submit their name, address, and social security number to the Barton County Sheriff's Office, as this information is needed to conduct a National Crime Information Center background check. The Review Board will then interview students that pass the background check. Scholarships will be awarded based on the interview and the following criteria:

- *Plan a career in Law Enforcement
- *Plan to attend Barton County Community College

EACH YEAR THE BARTON COUNTY SHERIFF'S RESERVES OFFER TWO ANNUAL SCHOLARSHIPS FOR A GRADUATING SENIOR OR A STUDENT ATTENDING BARTON COUNTY COMMUNITY COLLEGE. FOR THE STUDENT TO QUALIFY THE FOLLOWING ITEMS MUST BE MET:

1. THEY MUST BE A RESIDENT OF BARTON COUNTY.
2. THEY MUST BE SEEKING A CAREER IN LAW ENFORCEMENT.
3. THEY MUST BE PLANNING TO ATTEND BARTON COUNTY COLLEGE.

OUR OBJECTIVE WITH THIS SCHOLARSHIP IS TO PRODUCE NEW LAW ENFORCEMENT PERSONNEL FOR FUTURE EMPLOYEMENT IN BARTON COUNTY. EACH SCHOLARSHIP WILL BE FOR \$250.00. APPLICATIONS CAN BE SENT TO THE BARTON COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE AT 1416 KANSAS IN GREAT BEND, KANSAS. SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED UNTIL APRIL 9TH.
