

## **CLASS OF 1969 SCHOLARSHIP**

The GBHS Class of 1969 is offering a scholarship to a graduating senior. This scholarship may be used at any college or university. The recipient must be a son, daughter or grandchild of a class member from the class of 1969, have a 2.0 GPA demonstrate financial need and be a good citizen with a good attitude.

The application for this scholarship should be completed on a PC or typed and double-spaced. For the application to be complete, you must include ALL of the following:

- Name, address, parents' and siblings' names
- A brief statement about your family situation and family income
- A brief statement about your college and career plans
- List of extracurricular activities in which you have participated. List them in order of importance to you.
- List of honors and awards you have received in high school
- List your community services, activities, interests, and hobbies
- A brief description of your employment record
- A list of three persons whom the scholarship committee may contact for more information (teacher, employer, community member – not a relative). Please include an address and phone number
- A short statement answering the following: As you anticipate your future, what role do you hope to play in making this a better world?
- Parent and student signatures verifying that all information included in the application is correct to the best of your knowledge.

The Guidance Office will attach a copy of your transcript.
