

## CLASS OF 1971 SCHOLARSHIP

The GBHS Class of 1971 is offering a scholarship to a graduating senior.

Each year the Class of 1971 will honor a deceased student who was from the Class of 1971.

**For the 2009-10 school year, the Class of 1971 scholarship will honor “Ray Cheely”.** The scholarship will be for \$500 annually. The recipient must be a son, daughter, niece, nephew, cousin or grandchild of a class member from the class of 1971, demonstrate financial need, have a “C” or better GPA and be a good citizen with a positive attitude. Each year the Class Reunion Committee will meet and select a former student to honor.

The application for this scholarship should be completed on a PC or typed and double-spaced. For the application to be complete, you must include ALL of the following:

- Name, address, names of parents and siblings
- Name of the relative who is a 1971 graduate
- A brief statement about your family situation and family income
- A brief statement about your college and career plans
- List of extracurricular activities in which you have participated. List them in order of importance to you.
- List of honors and awards you have received in high school
- List your community services, activities, interests, and hobbies
- A brief description of your employment record
- A list of three persons whom the scholarship committee may contact for more information (teacher, employer, community member – not a relative), include an address and phone number for each.
- A short statement answering the following: As you anticipate your future, what role do you hope to play in making this a better world?

Parent and student signatures verifying that all information included in the application is correct to the best of your knowledge.

The Guidance Office will attach a copy of your transcript.
