Scholarship Announcement

The Sunflower Diversified Services Foundation will offer one scholarship of \$250 to a graduating senior residing in its five-county service area of Barton, Pawnee, Rice, Rush and Stafford counties, who is entering a field of study associated with services to persons with developmental disabilities, including special education, speech/language pathology, physical therapy, or occupational therapy. This opportunity is being extended to all high schools in the five-county area, so applicants will be competing against applicants from other high schools for this single scholarship.

For the application to be complete, the following information is requested.

- Name, address, and name of parents
- Statement of college and career plans, plus the school you plan to attend
- List of extracurricular activities in which you have participated
- List of honors and awards you have received in high school
- List of community services, activities, and interests
- Brief description of your employment record
- List of three persons that the Foundation Scholarship Committee may contact for more information (teacher, employer, community member – not a relative – along with an address and phone number for each)
- Signature to verify that the information is correct to the best of your knowledge.

The application should also include a copy of your transcript.

The Foundation Scholarship Committee will review all applications and will award the scholarship to the successful applicant. **Applications are due no later than April 8, 2011.** The successful applicant and the school guidance counselor will be notified no later than April 22nd.

The Foundation will issue a check to the recipient upon receipt of verification of enrollment.
