

Great Bend Area Panhellenic Scholarship

The Great Bend Area Panhellenic Scholarship was established several years ago by members of the Great Bend Panhellenic. This organization is composed of women in the Great Bend area that belonged to social sororities while attending college. These women have chosen to give a scholarship to any young woman who will participate in Greek Rush with the hopes of pledging a college sorority. The applicant must be attending a college where there are Greek Social/Philanthropic Sororities and the scholarship will not be sent to the recipient's school until Panhellenic receives notification that the scholarship winner completed rush week.

The application for this scholarship will be completed on a PC or typed and double-spaced. This scholarship will be given on the basis of: academics, leadership and activity involvement. For the application to be complete, you must include all of the following:

- Name, address, name of parents and siblings
- A brief statement about your college and career plans
- List of extracurricular activities in which you have participated
List them in order of their importance to you
- List of honors and awards you have received in high school
- List your community services, activities, interests and hobbies
- Attach two letters of recommendation: one from a teacher and one from a member of your community or church
- A short statement answering the following: As you anticipate your future, what role do you hope to play in making this a better world and how do you think belonging to a sorority will help you accomplish this goal?
- Parent and student signatures verifying that all information included in the application is correct to the best of your knowledge

The guidance office will attach a copy of your transcript.
