

Roosevelt Junior High Scholarship

The Roosevelt Junior High Scholarship is for a graduating senior who lives east of Washington Street.

The application for this scholarship should be completed on a PC or typed and double-spaced. For the application to be complete, you must include ALL of the following:

- Name, address, name of parents and siblings
- A brief statement about your family situation and family income
- A brief statement about your college and career plans
- List of extracurricular activities in which you have participated. List them in order of their importance to you
- List of honors and awards you have received in high school
- List your community services, activities, interest, and hobbies
- A brief description of your employment record
- A list of three persons whom the scholarship committee may contact for more information (teacher, employer, community member – not relative); include an address and phone number
- A short statement answering the following: As you anticipate your future, what role do you hope to play in making this a better world?
- Parent and student signatures verifying that all information included in the application is correct to the best of your knowledge
