LDD Federal Government – Drug Free Schools (See GAOA, GAOB, IDAB, and JDDA) LDD

The unlawful possession, use, sale, or distribution of illicit drugs and alcohol by students or school employees on school premises or as a part of any school activity is prohibited. This policy, and any curriculum used in conjunction with it, shall be evaluated at least every other year using criteria developed by the superintendent and approved by the board. The board shall receive a report after each of these reviews is conducted.
